WEEKLY ROUNDUP: HALTON REACHES VACCINE ROLLOUT MILESTONE

Halton Public Health announced that the region has completed giving the first doses of COVID-19 vaccines to residents of long-term care and retirement homes.

Dr. Hamidah Meghani, Halton's medical officer of health, shared the milestone in a video update on Jan. 29.

"We are going to continue with our mobile teams to finish providing both doses of vaccine in long-term care and retirement homes as soon as we can," she said. "Our ability to roll out vaccines quickly remains dependent on an ongoing and predictable supply of vaccine."

She added: "Once we have more vaccine, we will focus on vaccinating additional priority populations so that we will hopefully

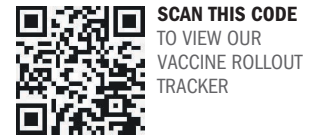
have fewer people dying from COVID-19 or needing to get hospital-level care."

Meanwhile, the number of new COVID-19 cases across the region is trending down.

Data from the region's website shows that from Jan. 22 to 28, there were 407 new infections in the region, down from 498 posted the previous week. The number of active cases stood at 313,

including 116 in Burlington, 95 in Milton, 59 in Oakville and 43 in Halton Hills.

As of Jan. 29, there have been 8,290 COVID-19 cases in Halton since the pandemic started, with 7,678 marked as resolved and 160 deaths.
