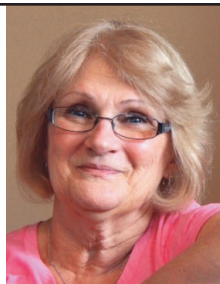

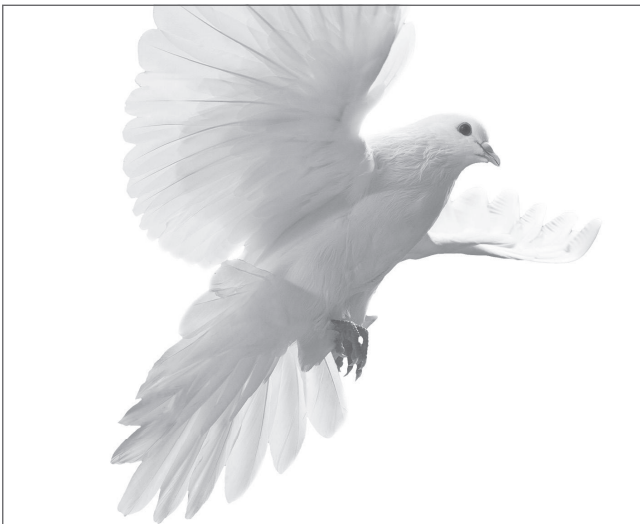
Of Guelph, lost her courageous battle with Covid 19, at Guelph General Hospital, on February 12, 2021, at the age of 86.
