NEARLY 100 NEW BEDS TO BE ADDED AT BENNETT CENTRE

A provincial investment in long-term care facilities means new beds for a Georgetown facility.

Last week Effie Triantafilopoulous, a Halton-area MPP and parliamentary assistant to the minister of long-term care, announced the Ontario government would make a \$933-million investment across 80 long-term care facilities.

In Georgetown, the Bennett Centre Long Term Care at Bennett Village will receive 94 new spaces, as well as 66 redeveloped spaces. Overall, Halton Region will see 1,565 new spaces and 291 redeveloped spaces for seniors.

"Residents in long-term care deserve a home that is safe and comfortable, close to their families and friends," Triantafilopoulos said in a prepared release. "Families want to know that their loved ones will receive the supports they need in long-term care."


