With spring here, Halton Hills residents can look forward to dining al fresco in Halton Hills.

Applications are now open for the Town of Halton Hills' 'Al Fresco in the Hills' program, an outdoor dining initiative designed

to support local restaurants, bars, and other food and drink establishments.

The program aids establishments in expanding dining capacity while adhering to public health regulations and COVID-19 safety guidelines.

'We were pleased to initiate the Al Fresco in the Hills program last year as a means to support our local food establishments throughout the pandemic," said Mayor Rick Bonnette.

"This industry in particular faced hardship so I was pleased to see so many businesses participating in this program.'

Al Fresco in the Hills launched in June 2020 to allow for temporary patios until Jan. 1, 2021.

The program was suspended during the winter months and will relaunch for the 2021 patio season. Temporary patios will be permitted until Jan. 31,

"I'm a big proponent of supporting local businesses and I can tell you that our restaurants have done a great job to continue serving the community while adhering to restrictions and keeping residents safe," Bonnette said.

As of press time, Halton remained under the Red/ Control level of Ontario's COVID-19 Response Framework.

At this level, restaurants, bars, and food and drink establishments can open for outdoor dining. Indoor dining is also permitted but limited to a capacity of 10 patrons (four per table) where physical distancing can be maintained.
