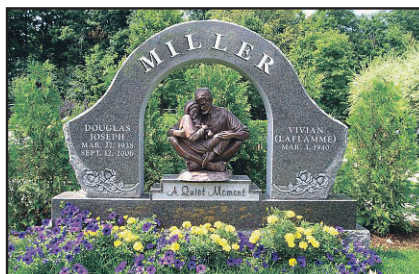
OLSEN, Reginald (Mike) R

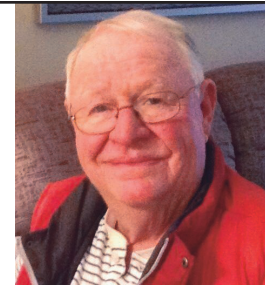
