September 16, 1933 - March 28, 2021



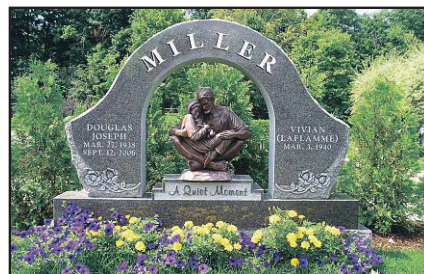
