## PREGNANT WOMEN CAN NOW BOOK VACCINE APPOINTMENT

Women who are expecting are the next group eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine at a Halton Region clinic. Pregnant women are now part of the "highest risk health conditions" category identified in Phase 2 of the Province's vaccine distribution plan.

They are encouraged to consult with their health-care provider about the benefits and risks associated with vaccination before booking an appointment.

That can be done at halton.ca/COVIDvaccines, where a complete list of who is eligible and who will be eligible soon can be found. Those needing further assistance can call 311. Halton residents can book an appointment at any of the six clinics throughout the region.
