April 25, 1928 - April 22, 2021



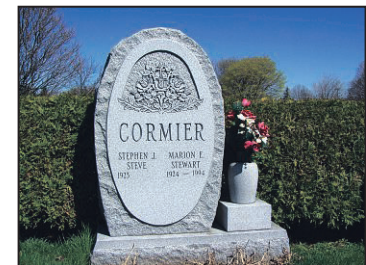
