SUMMER CAMP OPERATORS PREPARED FOR ALL SCENARIOS

MANY GROUPS READY TO OFFER VIRTUAL OR ALTERED PROGRAMS

Same restrictions, but a more positive outlook.

That's the scenario for summer camps in Halton Hills and across the region, as they head into another season amid the pandemic.

While facing similar obstacles this time around, most organizers — who had just a few weeks to make adjustments in 2020 — are feeling more ready to take on the challenges ahead.

Anna Drummond, owner of Georgetown's Fall-

brook Trail Ranch, is more confident heading into the summer now that COVID-related safety measures are more widely understood and followed.

She recalled, "When we started camp last year, not everybody was wearing masks; people were resistant to that."

With the natural distance associated with horseback riding, Fallbrook — where bubble groups were formed last summer to minimize the spread of COVID — is among the camps where masks will not always be required.

"The whole point is to enjoy nature and be outside," said Drummond, adding that campers and staff will wear masks

whenever in close proximity of one another.

Shelley Roddie of Cedar Springs is also more at ease with the summer to come.

"I definitely think this summer we're more prepared ... for sure," said the camp director of the health racquet and sports club program in Burlington.

Of course, not all camps will be operating in person this year. At least not exclusively.

The Great Big Theatre Company — which has a client base that includes youth in Halton Hills and many neighbouring communities — plans to offer virtual sessions once again, in addition to (hope-
