It's that time of year when the downtown streets are filled with vendors selling fresh produce, baked goods and more.

The Acton and Georgetown farmers markets are just around the corner. Here's everything you need to know:

1. The Acton market kicks off June 3 and runs on Thursday evenings (4 to 7 p.m.) through to Oct. 7, while the Georgetown market gets underway on June 5 and will run every Saturday until Oct. 16 from 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

2. In Georgetown, vendors will be located on Main Street South between Church and James streets, and in the Church

Street parking lot. The Acton market will be set up on Willow Street North, between Mill and Bower streets, in front of the Town Hall Centre.

3. With the pandemic continuing, the events have COVID-19 protocols in place, including social distancing requirements, additional cleaning measures, masking, etc.

market is establishing a unique online platform where vendors can display their products and take orders, which will be available for pickup on Saturday mornings in the Back Street parking lot. Further details to come at the website below.
