January 1, 1939 - May 25, 2021

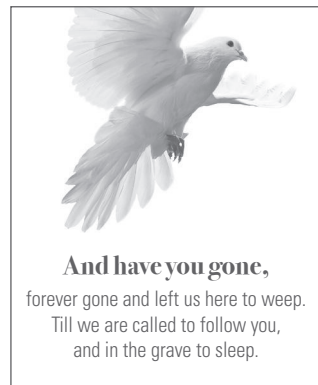
