## **WEEKLY ROUNDUP: HALTON ACCELERATES SECOND VACCINE DOSES**

Halton is accelerating the rollout of second dose vaccines, allowing those who received their first CO-VID-19 vaccine shot on or before May 30 to get their second dose faster.

"We are pleased to be able to offer earlier second dose appointments to more residents," said Halton Regional Chair Gary Carr in a media release.

"We continue to make great progress and have already vaccinated almost 75 per cent of our 12+ community with the first dose, and 13 per cent have received both doses."

As per the provincial guideline, those who received the AstraZeneca vaccine as their first dose have to wait for eight weeks

before they can book for their second dose.

As for the weekly CO-VID-19 cases, the region's website shows that from June 11 to 17 there were 88 new cases, down from 155 the previous week. No new deaths were reported.

As of June 18, the number of active COVID-19 cases stood at 88 — with 29 cases in Burlington, 28 in Milton, 24 in Oakville, and

seven in Halton Hills. There have been 17,893 cases of COVID-19 during the pandemic, with 17,576 marked as resolved and 229 deaths.
