The Town of Halton Hills is looking to support individuals, organizations, and community groups actively taking steps to reduce their carbon footprints through mitigation and adaptation measures.

Applicants are eligible for \$2,000 from a funding budget of \$15,000 available in 2021 from the Town's Climate Change Investment Fund. "This funding demonstrates our commitment to addressing climate change," Mayor Rick Bonnette said. "All the climate change actions we take now to reduce our carbon footprint will make a difference today and tomorrow."

The funding stems from a Climate Change Emergency Declaration made by Halton Hills council in 2019. The declaration set a target to become a carbon neutral community by
