## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Trafalgar Road (Reg. Rd. 3) Widening from Steeles Avenue (Reg. Rd. 8) to 10 Side Road (Reg. Rd. 10) Town of Halton Hills | PR-2961B



Beginning in August 2021, Halton Region will begin widening Trafalgar Road (Reg. Rd. 3) to four lanes between Steeles Avenue and 10 Side Road, Ward 2, in the Town of Halton Hills. The work also includes installation of a watermain on Trafalgar Road, from the Ashgrove Pumping Station and Reservoir to 10 Side Road, and on 10 Side Road from Trafalgar Road to Eighth Line.

The expected completion date is December 2024.

Access for local residents will be maintained at all times.
