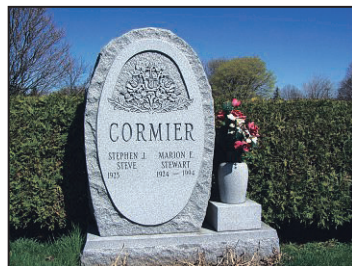

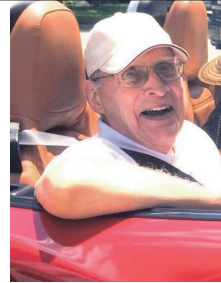

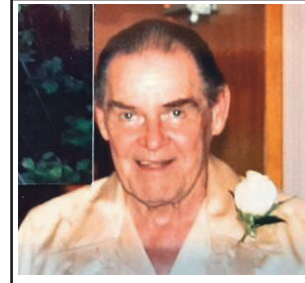

JOHNSTON, Donald Newton

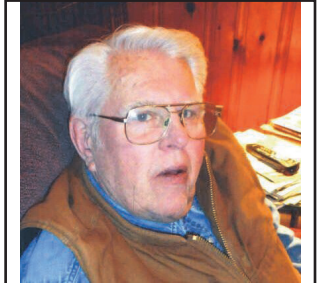
