► FEDERAL ELECTION SWASTIKA VANDALISM FOUND ON ELECTION SIGN

Halton police are investigating after a swastika was spray painted on a federal election sign in Georgetown.

The sign — which was situated at Maple Avenue and Main Street South belongs to Wellington-Halton Hills People's Party of Canada candidate Syl Carle, who decried the vandalism as "a disgraceful act" that "leaves a stain on our democratic process."



Sign vandalism has become a significant issue in the Wellington-Halton Hills riding during the federal election campaign.

"It's incumbent on all candidates and volunteers, regardless of their political allegiance, to condemn these acts," he said in a statement to the Independent. "PPC volunteers have gone so far as to repair signage of our competitors when they come across a broken sign, because our democracy is far more important than one specific party."

Halton Regional Police media relations officer Const. Ryan Anderson confirmed the incident has been reported to the local

force and that police are investigating.

When asked if the vandalism is being investigated as a hate crime, he said: "At this point, nothing can be ruled out when it comes to the motivation for the offence."

Anderson said anyone identified stealing or damaging a political sign could be charged with mischief or theft under \$5,000 under the Criminal Code of Canada.

Recently, local Liberal candidate Melanie Lang also reported that several of her signs have been broken, spray-painted, set on fire and even run over, with the latter filmed as part of an angry TikTok video where the driver shouts a profanity as he smashes into the sign with his vehicle.

Halton Police are investigating these incidents as well.
