- Weight: 1 to 5 ounces

- Although chipmunks hibernate, they do not store fat. Instead they slowly gnaw away at their summer bounty throughout the winter.

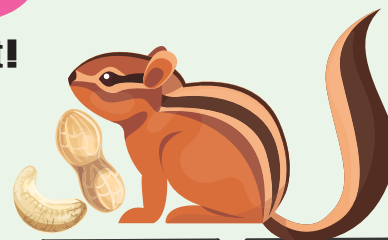
- Chipmunks are part of the squirrel family

- The chipmunk's main defense against predators is speed: sensing danger, it darts into a nearby tree hole or log for protection.

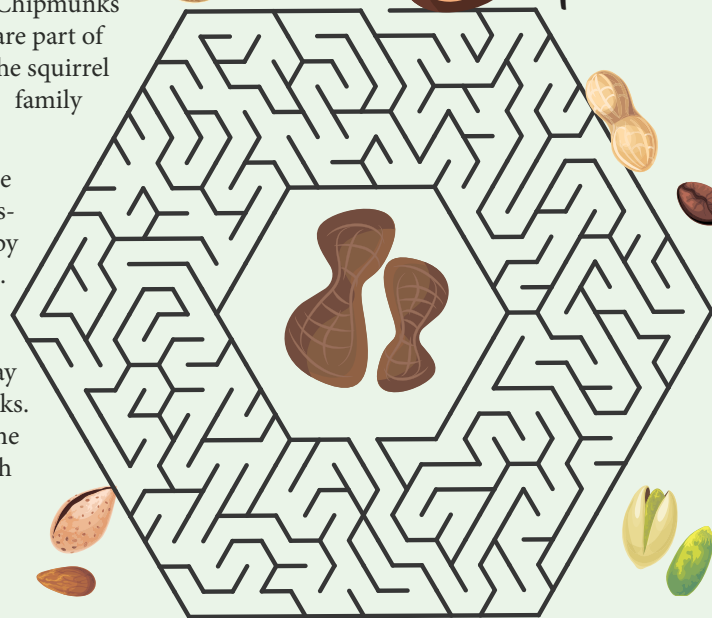
- Chipmunk young are born in late spring, and stay in the nest for up to six weeks. Female chipmunks have one or two litters per year, each with four or five babies.

- Average life span in the wild: 2 to 3 years

- Size: 4 to 7 inches; tail: 3 to 5 inches

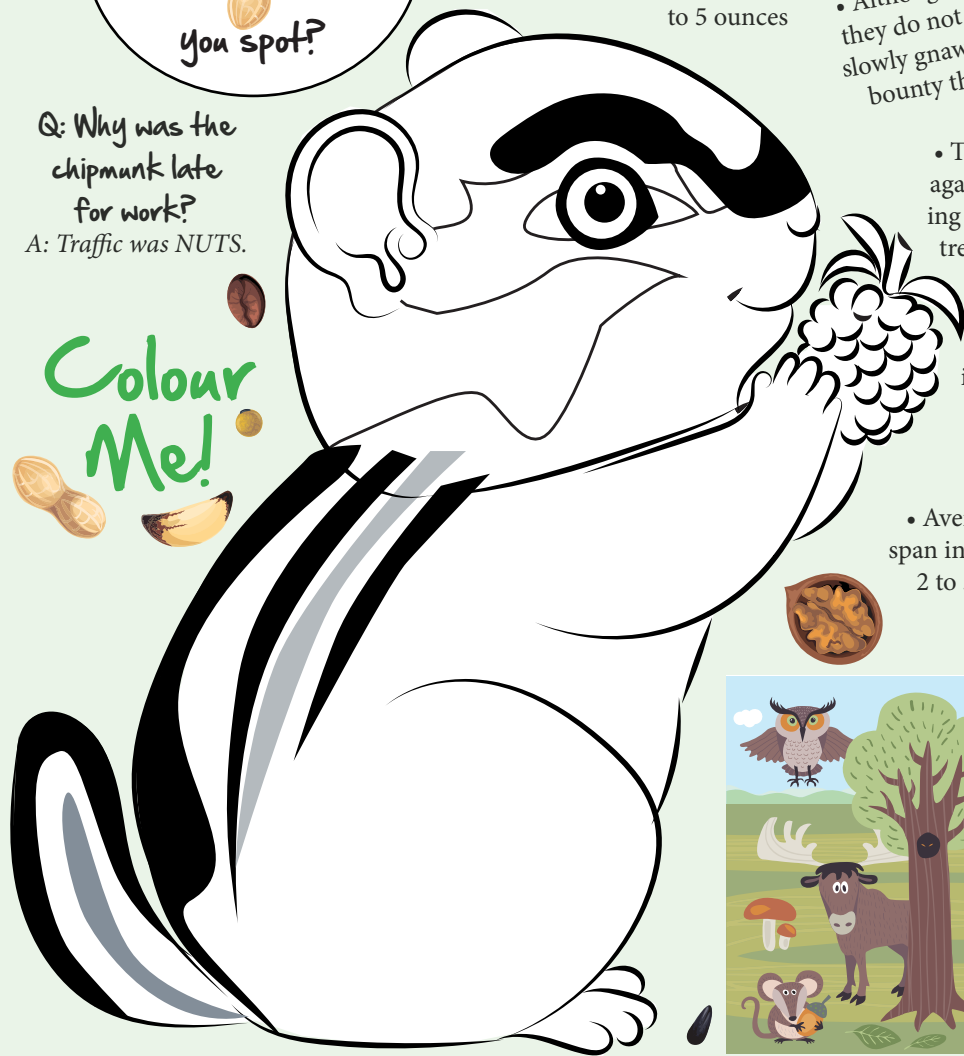


Help the chipmunk find his peanuts.
