

■ NEWS LEARN THE SIGNIFICANCE OF SEPT. 30

For the first time on Sept. 30, this country will observe the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. If the combination of the date and subject matter sound familiar, it's because Sept. 30 was recognized as Orange Shirt Day for eight years before the federal government elevated the occasion to statutory holiday status.

Even if you were familiar with the reasons why some people wore orange on Sept. 30, there's a lot you can still learn about the legacy of cultural genocide committed in residential schools across Canada. To learn more, consider these resources.

WRITINGS OF PHYLLIS WEBSTAD

The Orange Shirt Day website details the holiday's origin as an event initially organized by Esketemc (Alkali Lake) Chief Fred Robbins and kept alive by Phyllis (Jack) Webstad. Visit orangeshirtday.org/ about-us. After you've learned about the meaning of the colour orange, the historical significance of Sept. 30 and the spirit behind the movement, check out Webstad's four published books on the subject.

ONLINE COURSES

Universities offer free online courses intended to deepen our understanding of the history and issues impacting Indigenous peoples in this country. Courses such as Aboriginal Worldviews and Education and Indigenous Canada are available through Coursera.org.

GRANDMOTHER'S VOICE

This organization of Indigenous women offers free educational resources and workshops through its website, grandmothersvoice.com.
