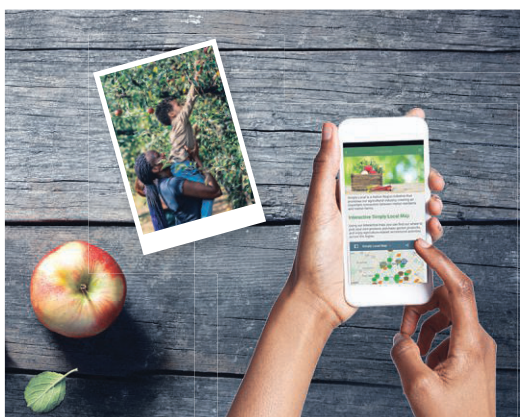


Experience local farms and markets with Simply Local
