WEEKLY ROUNDUP: ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES DOWN 20 PER CENT

Halton Region reported 122 new cases of COVID-19 between Sept. 30-Oct. 6.

The average of 17.4 cases per day was down from the previous week's average of 23.9.

There were 49 cases in Oakville, 35 in Burlington, 31 in Milton and seven in Halton Hills.

The number of active cases in the region dropped by more than 20 per cent from the previous week,

from 129 to 103.

There were 5,412 doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered during the week (an average of 773 per day), with one-third of them being first doses. Of eligible Halton residents, 87 per cent have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine while 83 per cent have received two. In Ontario, 81.8 per cent of eligible residents are fully vaccinated.

The highest rate of infection is among those ages 20-39, with 26.9 cases per

100,000 people. Only two age groups in Halton have less than 80 per cent of the population fully vaccinated, 25-29 (71 per cent) and 30-34 (76 per cent).

The number of outbreaks in the region dropped from 17 to four, with the biggest decline in school outbreaks, which went from 13 to three.

The region's longest ongoing outbreak, at Hampton Terrace long-term care home, was also declared over. Declared on Sept. 18, the outbreak resulted in 34 cases and two deaths. As of press time, there had not been a COVID-19-related death in Halton in three weeks.
