According to CFIB, as of October 19, only 39 per cent of small businesses are making normal sales. The most recent CFIB "Small Business Recovery Dashboard" reports that 78 per cent of Canadian small businesses are fully open and 45 per cent a fully staffed. The report shows that 28 per cent of small business operators cannot find all the staff they need.
