

FEEDBACK SOUGHT ON NEW SKATE PARK PLANS

The Town of Halton Hills plans to replace the skate park at Mold-Masters SportsPlex and is currently seeking public input on its design.

A virtual workshop hosted by town staff and

New Line Skateparks is scheduled for Nov. 24 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.

During the session, residents will have the chance to review design concepts for the new community-sized skate park on Guelph Street in Georgetown and provide feedback.

Based on the informa-

tion gathered during the workshop, the design will be refined into a final concept, which will then be reviewed in another consultation that will take place this winter.

Pending approval of next year's capital budget, construction is slated to start in the spring and wrap up in summer 2022.
