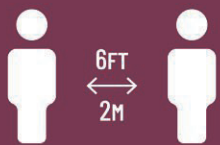

## COURT HEARS CASE OF CATHOLIC TRUSTEE CHARGED WITH FRAUD

THE MATTER WILL RETURN TO COURT ON DEC. 21

The legal matter of an Oakville Catholic school board trustee who has been charged with fraud was briefly heard in Hamilton court on Nov. 16.

The attorney representing Nancy Guzzo — who did not make an appearance in court — told the court that a resolution meeting has been scheduled for Nov. 29.

The matter will return to court on Dec. 21.

Guzzo was charged by Hamilton police on Jan. 21,

2021, with 10 counts of fraud under \$5,000 and two counts of fraud over \$5,000, related to her employment with the Laborers' International Union of North America (LIUNA), specifically in her position as assistant business manager for LIUNA Local 3000.

She was assistant business manager for LIUNA Local 3000 between March 2018 and April 2019 and prior to that, business manager and secretary-treasurer for Local 1110, according to LinkedIn.

In a previous statement, Guzzo said she could not share details that would help provide context since the matter is before the courts.

"What I can disclose, is that I was a 20-year employ-

ee of LIUNA until March of 2019, at which time I was dismissed without cause. I cannot comment further, but I look forward to being able to share my side of this situation as this legal process plays out.

"It has been an exceptionally trying period of time, and I would like to thank the members of our community who have reached out to me. The kindness and support I have been shown have given me strength," she said back in October.

The Oakville trustee said she would remain committed to upholding her duties as trustee for the Halton Catholic District School Board.
