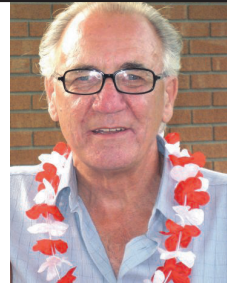

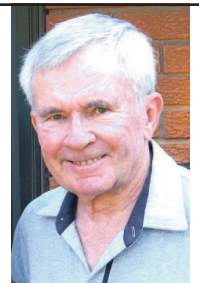
**MACKENZIE, Jack (Jake)
