

MAYOR URGES SUPPORT OF LOCAL RESTAURANTS

As increased pandemic restrictions come into effect, Mayor Rick Bonnette is encouraging the community to get behind Halton Hills dining establishments.

"I am hearing from restaurants who have ordered supplies to prepare for indoor dining that are now deeply concerned as they will not only suffer lost revenue, but may also have to discard unused food," he said.

"That's why I am committed to ordering in from a local eatery a few times a week. I encourage families (for those who can afford it) to adopt a similar routine — perhaps Takeout Tuesdays — so as to support our local eating establishments."

The Ontario government moved the province into a modified Step 2 of its Roadmap to Reopen on Jan. 5 in an effort to slow the spread of the COVID-19 Omicron variant and prevent hospitals from becoming

overwhelmed.

The regulations mean that indoor dining, theatres, museums, indoor sports and recreation facilities are closed until at least Jan. 26, while stores, shopping malls and personal care businesses are limited to 50 per cent capacity.

The Town of Halton Hills says it's continuing to implement its economic recovery and resiliency action plan, which includes short-term actions to support immediate recovery efforts and long-term investment growth actions.
