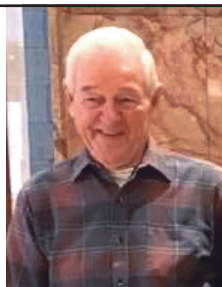

February 17, 1936 - December 30, 2021

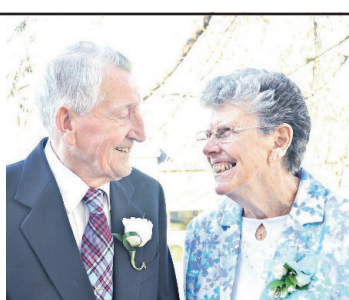

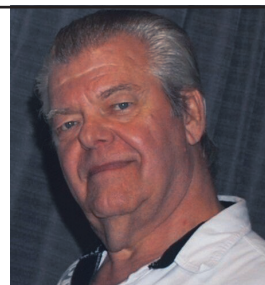
