Notice of Received Application Concerning an Application for an Amendment to the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan

Municipal Address: Part of Lots 11, 12 and 13, Concession 1, 10305 - 10379 & 10479 Nassagaweya Esquesing Townline (Esquesing), Halton Hills
File No.: D09OPA21.005

This notice is to advise that the Town of Halton Hills has received a development application for the above listed properties to redesignate in the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan a portion of the subject lands from "Escarpment Rural Area" to "Mineral Resource Extraction Area" to allow for a 30.2 ha expansion (15.9 ha extraction area) to the existing Milton Quarry (Milton Quarry East Extension). The proposal is also subject to an amendment to the Region of Halton Official Plan and to the Niagara Escarpment Plan.

Notes: The Town will be processing the application in accordance with the Planning Act. The application is being circulated to Town Departments and Agencies for review.

Members of the public are invited to obtain information, express their views, or make a written submission regarding the development proposal. A Statutory Public Meeting will also be held before Town Council to inform and consult with the public about the submitted application. A separate newspaper notice will be provided at a later date confirming the day, time and location of the Public Meeting.

Notification: If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills on the proposed Official Plan Amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills Planning & Development Department, 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, ON, L7G 5G2.

Legal Notices Required Under the Planning Act:

1. If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of Town of Halton Hills Council to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.
2. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

Any written comment/objection submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding this application, which is being processed under the Planning Act, may be made public as part of the application process.
