It's almost that time to bundle up and help raise funds for a local community support agency.

Here's everything you need to know about the Coldest Night of the Year event:

- 1. The walkathon is slated for Feb. 26 and will benefit Links2Care, which offers programs such as meal delivery for seniors, friendly visiting, community food pantry and homelessness intervention. The local non-profit says the pandemic has made these supports more crucial than ever for vulnerable residents.
- 2. The walk will start at Links2Care's Georgetown office, 360 Guelph St., with registration opening at 4 p.m. and the walk kicking off at 5:15 p.m.
- 3. Individual participants and teams have the option of walking two- or five-kilometre routes to raise money for the cause. Children are welcome to participate as well.
- 4. Local residents who are unable to do the walk can also fill a variety of volunteer positions during the event. Sign up at cnoy.org/volunteer.
- 5. Links2Care is holding a sign up/donation event at Georgetown Marketplace on Feb. 11 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the food court at Georgetown Marketplace, with goodies provided by Terra Cotta Cookies.
