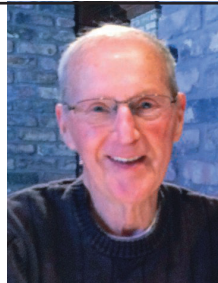
MUELLER, Barbara (Klein), 77
