

LIVING WITH CANCER IN THE COVID AGE

WELLSPRING OFFERS WEALTH OF VIRTUAL SUPPORT PROGRAMS

A cancer diagnosis's psychological and emotional impact is only exacerbated when the devastating news comes during a global pandemic.

Patients are already dealing with isolation, virtual appointments and worries about CO-VID-19 and an immunocompromised condition, said Ilene Shiller, a manager and trained social worker with Wellspring, which offers support programs for those in Halton Hills - and across the region — living with cancer.

"Then layer onto that the fact that your surgery or your treatment schedule gets changed around, (or) gets delayed," said Shiller. "We're seeing a lot more fear because you have to worry about (the) impact on the progression of the disease."

When Wellspring's doors were shuttered in March 2020, its programs quickly switched to virtual. The move not only allowed clients to resume their sessions but made accessibility to program-
