GUELPH STREET INTERSECTIONS SET FOR UPGRADES

The intersection of Guelph Street and Sinclair Avenue is slated for resurfacing, maintenance and more this summer.

Plans are being rolled out for summer infrastructure work around Halton Hills.

The town has announced some of its proposed roadway improvements, including:

- Turn lane modifications and reconstruction of the signalized intersections at Guelph Street and Sinclair Avenue, and Guelph and Mill streets;
- Road resurfacing and maintenance on Sinclair Avenue from Duncan Drive to Guelph Street, including the intersection;
- New off-road active transportation facilities on Sinclair Avenue between Duncan Drive and Guelph Street;
- Lighting to accommodate new and existing infrastructure.

"Ongoing work to renew and improve infrastructure across Halton Hills is part of the town's annual roads program," said Mayor Rick Bonnette. "We do our best to minimize impacts during construction, but residents should expect localized traffic closures."

I am separated. I had a personal injury matter that settled. Is any of the settlement proceeds relevant to my family law matter?

A

We have handled a number of these situations. The settlement is likely entirely relevant as you have to provide full and frank financial disclosure. However, some of the settlement may be exempt from being considered or divided in the family law process. For instance, "general damages", i.e. damages for pain and suffering, are considered exempt and not subject to division or sharing. Amounts paid as part of the settlement for past and/or future income loss may very well be relevant to issues of determining support obligations. It is usually necessary to get full details of the settlement breakdown, as well as past and future medical documentation if the injured party is taking the position he or she has been and continues to be unable to work. 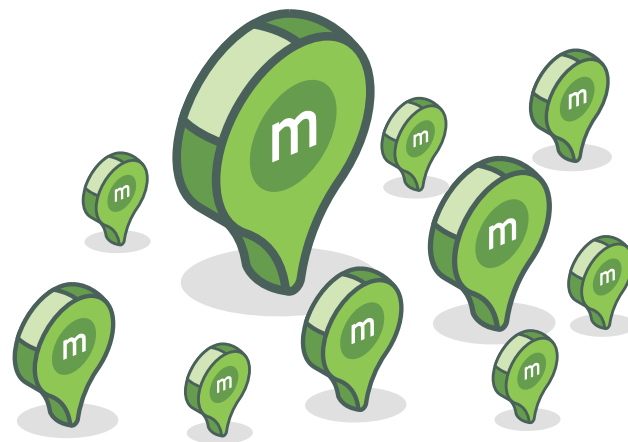
