February 9, 1942 - March 23, 2022



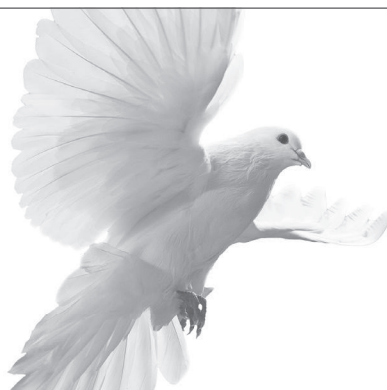
