There is no fee for registering as a Third Party Advertiser.

Candidates that wish to file a nomination form must contact the Clerk's Office at clerks@haltonhills.ca to book an appointment for filing. The first day for filing a nomination form is May 2, 2022 during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.), with the last day for filing being August 19, 2022 (8:30 a.m. until 2 p.m.). The nomination form, endorsement form and candidate information are available on the Town of Halton Hills website at haltonhills.ca/election or a candidate package can be picked up at the Service Halton Hills Counter at Town Hall during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.)

A prescribed fee which may be refundable, in the amount of \$200 for Mayoral candidates and \$100 for all other candidates payable by cash, certified cheque, money order, or by debit, must accompany the nomination form as well as 25 signatures endorsing the nomination. (Please Note: 25 signatures of endorsement are not required for School Board Trustees)

A person who proposes to be a candidate may not solicit or accept contributions for election purposes, or incur expenses, until after that person has filed a nomination paper with the Town Clerk.
