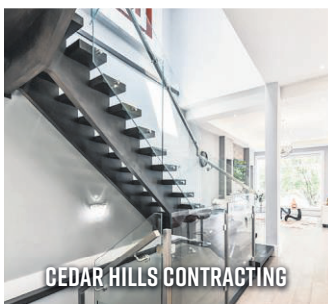
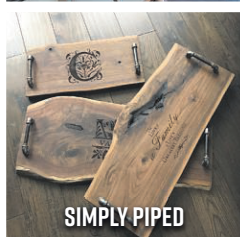

OVER 100 TOWN EMPLOYEES ON 2021 SUNSHINE LIST

The Town of Halton Hills now has more than 100 staff members earning over \$100,000 per year, according to the recently-published Sunshine List.

The document — which is released annually to disclose the names and salaries of Ontario public sector employees who make in excess of \$100,000 — shows there are 108 staff members working for the local municipality who reached this benchmark in 2021, up from the previous year's 98.

Topping the list is Halton Hills Chief Administrative Officer Chris Mills, who earned \$240,348.67. Mills took over the reins in an acting

capacity at first when former CAO Brent Marshall went on leave in August 2020.

In November 2021, Halton Hills council released a statement indicating Marshall was no longer employed by the municipality, and that it "does not comment on personnel matters and will not be issuing additional informa-

tion on this matter."

During the time Marshall was on the town payroll in 2021, he earned \$141,921.46 — down from his salary of \$267,597.25 in 2020.

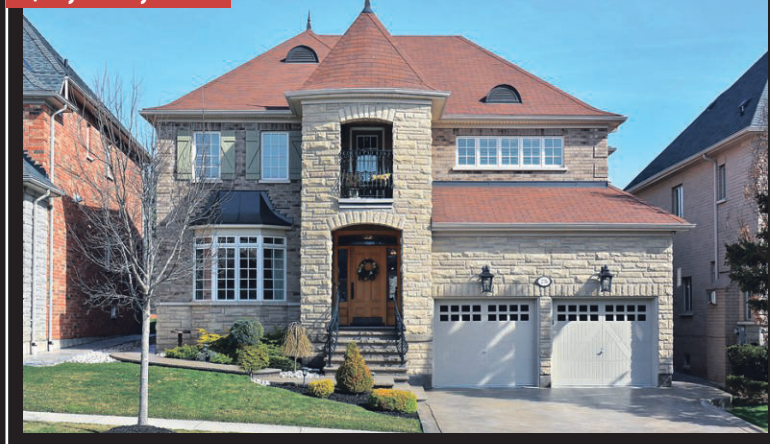
Town department heads were next up on the list of top earners in Halton Hills. Commissioner of Planning and Development John Linhardt took home \$202,204.88, while Commissioner of Recreation and Parks Warren Harris made \$202,204.87.

Laura Lancaster — commissioner of corporate services — was the top-earning female on staff at \$168,913.61.

Meanwhile, Mayor Rick Bonnette was the highest-paid politician at town hall, making \$156,566.54 (earnings from both the town and Halton Region, where he also serves on council).

About a third of the Halton Hills employees who made the Sunshine List are local firefighters.
