LOUTH, Betty (Elizabeth) June



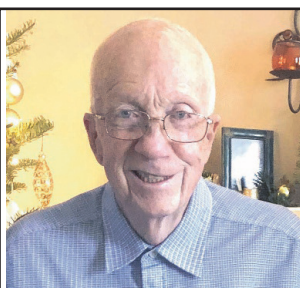
