WANT TO VOTE IN THE PROVINCIAL ELECTION?

Want to vote in the provincial election?

Here's a list of ways you can cast that ballot.

- You can vote in person on June 2 from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. at the voting location assigned to you based on your current residential address.
- You can vote at any of the advance voting locations in your electoral district. Advance voting locations are open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- You can vote at your returning office in person from the day after an election in your electoral district has been called, until 6 p.m. the day before election day.
- You can vote by mail, however, to do so you must complete a vote by mail application and provide a copy of at least one piece of government-issued ID. The deadline to apply to vote by mail is 6 p.m. on May 27. Elections Ontario must re-



ceive your completed voting kit by 6 p.m. on June 2 (election day) for it to be counted.

- You can vote at home if: you are unable to go to your voting location because of a disability; you are unable to read or write; you are unable to complete an application form; and/or you are someone who requires assistance. Under these circumstances, two election officials will bring a voting kit to vour home to assist you in voting.
- You can vote if you are in hospital. As part of a three-day hospital program, election officials visiting participating hospitals during the general election will bring voting kits to the hospital to give temporarily hospitalized electors the opportunity to vote.
