
Georgetown Farmers Market

The Town of Halton Hills is undertaking an assessment for improvements to Eighth Line from Steeles Avenue to Maple Avenue, due to increased population and greater demand on our roads network. Following an extensive evaluation, the preferred solution is to widen Eighth Line within the study area with improvements to be made to the existing road infrastructure and active transportation features. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be made available for public input once the study is completed.
