It's a job seeker's market. "Not unlike the general labour market, there are lots of summer jobs available for students and in every industry. People can pretty much pick and choose," said Lily Lumsden, senior regional manager, YMCA Employment and Immigrant Services, YMCA of Hamilton, Burlington and Brant-

ford. Statistics Canada data indicates that Halton youth aged 15-24 had an unemployment rate of 11.8 per cent during the first quarter of this year, a decrease over last year's 20.1 per cent unemployment rate, according to John Davidson, director of economic development at Halton Region.
