LEWIS, Bruce Erwin

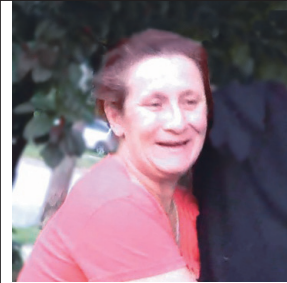
