A two-vehicle crash in Milton last week claimed the life of a Halton Hills man.

The two-vehicle crash occurred in the area of Martin Street and Market Drive, around 11:30 a.m. on July 4

A white Ford Focus was travelling northbound on Market Drive, crossed over the centre median and struck a southbound Hvundai Elantra, police said in a news release.

The driver of the Ford Focus — a 37-year-old man from Georgetown — was

transported to Milton District Hospital, where he was pronounced dead, said Const. Steve Elms.

The other motorist was not seriously injured.


