

# THREE SOUGHT IN ALLEGED PHARMACY ROBBERY, COLLISION

Halton police are looking for three suspects following the alleged robbery of a Halton Hills pharmacy on July 25.

At 12:45 p.m., three masked male youths entered the Pharmasave at 21 Main St. N. in Acton and demanded narcotics and cash, police said.

The pharmacy employees complied at which point the three individuals fled the scene in a 2015 Toyota Corolla, police said.

No weapons were seen or used. Shortly after the robbery, it's alleged these same individuals were involved in a collision on Regional Road 25, south of No. 17 Sideroad.

The individuals reportedly abandoned their vehicle and disappeared from

the area. Police said that despite an exhaustive search by officers accompanied by a K9 unit, the three individuals could not be located and remain at large. The stolen cash and narcotics were recovered following the crash, police say. No injuries were reported as a result of the robbery or collision.

Police are asking anyone with dash camera footage that was taken in the area of the reported robbery between noon and 1 p.m. to contact them.

## SUSPECT SMASHES WINDOW TO GET INSIDE HOME

Halton police are looking for one suspect fol-

lowing a break-in to a Halton Hills home on Sunday, July 24. At around 1:30 a.m., a man approached a residence on No. 10 Side Road, near 8th Line, and smashed a front window to get inside, police said.

The intruder attempted to enter the garage through a man-door in the home, but the door was locked, and the suspect could not pry it open.

Police said the individual then fled the dwelling empty-handed.

No one was home at the time of the break-in.

The suspect is described as wearing a dark motorcycle helmet without the visor or face shield. He also wore jeans and a dark zip-up jacket with a white shirt underneath.
