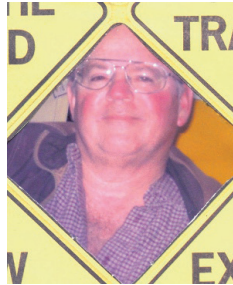
HILTS, Helen Loretta

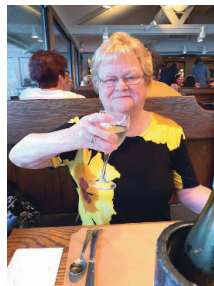
