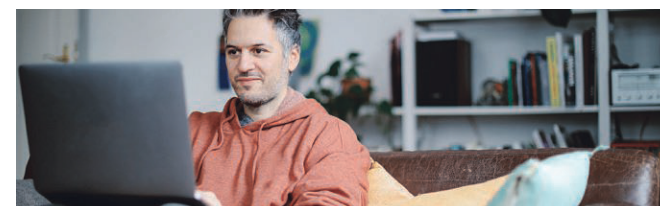
## Helping job seekers find employment in Halton
