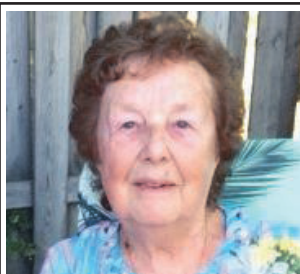
"The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore." Psalm 121:8

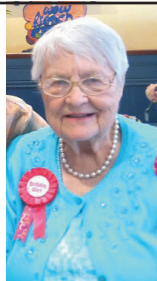


JAMES, Donna

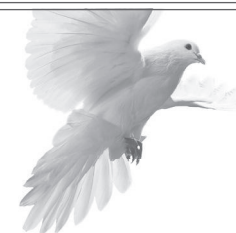
