

Household holiday waste collection

There are no holiday collection delays for Halton residents this year.

Holiday collection reminders:

- You do not need garbage bag tags on the first garbage collection after Christmas Day. The six garbage bag/can limit applies.
- Please make sure containers and bags are visible to collection crews, and are free of snow and ice. Do not place on top of snowbanks or on the road surface to ensure streets are clear for snow removal.
- Christmas trees will be picked up during the weeks of January 9 and 16, 2023 on your scheduled collection day. Please remove all decorations, tree stands and plastic bags prior to collection.

Blue Box

- Aluminum foil, trays and pop cans
- Boxed beverage containers
- Plastic bottles
- Plastic plates and cups



Green Cart

- Leftover turkey, including bones
- Buns and stuffing
- Paper plates and cups
- Napkins
- Tissue paper free of tape or glitter



Garbage

- Plastic cutlery
- "Compostable" plastic cups and cutlery
- Styrofoam
- Holiday gift wrap
- Disposable masks and gloves



Waste collection requirements:

- Place waste securely at the curb by 7 a.m. on collection day and no sooner than 5 p.m. the night before.
- Please ensure containers or bins weigh no more than 23 kg (50 lbs).
- Bag and tie all garbage and Green Cart material.
- Wrap mattresses and box springs in plastic before placing at the curb for bulk waste collection.
