First TEAM mothers graduate

Success, in the form of two high school diplomas, rewarded the efforts of all those involved in Acton's Teen Education and Motherhood (TEAM) program.

Karen Honeywell and Shawna Somerville are the first graduates from the Acton branch of this very young Halton Region program which helps make it possible for young pregnant women and young mothers to finish their high school education. They received their diplomas on June 8 at Acton Baptist Church, the site of their past year's studies.

The other three students who remained in the program this year also received certificates of credit for the courses which they completed.

Courses available, using Independent Learning Centre material, include consumer studies, English, mathematics, personal life managements, geography, guidance - career planning, and history. Students work at their own pace but have the help of teachers who are provided by The Adult and Continuing Education Department of Halton Board of Education.

The graduation ceremony, organized by Acton program coordinator, Donna Kerton, had an unusual but very appropriate feature: all the children of the students were welcomed to join and given the freedom to participate in their own way.

They reminded everyone, simply by their presence, of the important roles they played in the program. Besides being the reason for it all, they were also the "students" in the other half of the TEAM program.

Making classes and teachers available is only one aim of TEAM. Providing good child care on site where a new mom can be reassured that her baby is happy and be able to nurse him if she wishes is just as important.

Classes will start again in September. Students can start anytime after that. Classes in both Acton and Georgetown are held in the afternoon, Monday to Friday. A guidance counsellor helps with career planning. During the weekly Community Day, a public health nurse or representatives from other organizations give presentations and lead discussions to help participants learn more about community resources or topics which have value for them.

It has been estimated that there are about 70 mothers under the age of 23 in the Acton area who are not secondary school graduates. Anyone interested in this program can call 878-1240 for information.

FAVOURITE STRAWBERRY RECIPES

STRAWBERRY FLUFF

- 1 pkg. strawberry jello
- 2 egg whites
- 2 cups sweetened strawberries

Prepare jello as directed on package. When it begins to set, whip till stiff. Whip egg whites stiff using 2 tbsp. sugar. Sweeten berries and leave for awhile to let sugar coat them. Fold beaten egg whites into whipped jello and mix in strawberries a small amount at a time. Allow to stand in refrigerator for a short time before serving. Serve plain or with whipped cream.

STRAWBERRY PUNCH

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup water
- 2 cups pineapple juice
- 2 cups orange juice
- 1 cup crushed ice
- 1 cup lemon juice
- 1 quart fresh strawberries, sliced
- 1 quart carbonated water or ginger ale

Boil sugar and water about 10 minutes. Cool syrup. Add remaining ingredients, except ice. Pour into punch bowl. Float ice.
