## Raiders set to start 92-93 season

Charlie Hanman has that itch again, so hockey season must be right around the corner.

The coach of the Georgetown

Chrysler Raiders can't wait for the 1992-93 Central Ontario Junior Hockey League season to get underway. And Hanman won't

have to wait long as the Raiders open their campaign tonight, hosting the Burlington Cougars at the Alcott Arena.

Faceoff time is 7:30 p.m.

The Raiders finished their exhibition season Tuesday, losing an 11-2 decision to the Hamilton Kilty B's in the Steel City. The defeat left Georgetown with a 2-4 pre-season record, which didn't concern Hanman.

"I don't start thinking about wins and losses until Christmas," Hanman said.

But the contest was a costly one injury wise. Defenceman Ante Galic left suffered a hip injury and is questionable for the season open-

er, and right-winger Dean Roberts, who joined the Raiders after attending the Guelph Storm's OHL camp, suffered an elbow injury that has resulted in eight stitches and a cast on his arm.

Raiders' officials are holding their breath hoping no bone chips are found in Roberts' elbow, which would limit his absence to only a week.

Hanman enters the season pleased with his goaltending and forwards, but cautiously optimistic about a very young defence. Only veteran Steve Weishar, who during the preseason proved more than capable of taking a leadership role on the blueline, is the lone return-

ing veteran.

Promising rookies Galic, Kevin Moxey and Justin Parks, along with Jason Huminiuck and Jon McKee, both of whom have limited Jr. B experience with Newmarket and Mimico respectively, give Hanman talent but limited defensive experience.

"That (experience on defence) will be our problem, but if we can keep these defencemen together they will develop," Hanman said. "I think a guy like Jason Parks, who slipped in the back door as a walk-on, will surprise a lot of people."

The inexperienced defence corps
