district.
Rather than simply receive the report for information purposes, Councillor Ron Chatten suggested that it be referred to 1993 budget talks when the possibility of acquiring modern leaf collection equipment will be discussed.

According to the report, the new town-wide system of collection, which includes the use of refuse

packers touring town streets on six specified collection days, will cost about \$150 per tonne this year, with the possibility of a reduction to \$120 per tonne if the system is continued and streamlined. There are two types of vacuum systems which the town could consider, the report said. One is a liquid-cooled vacuum leaf loader, which is trailer mounted. With accessories, it costs about \$18,400.

The other possibility is a pull behind tri-axle trailer with the leaf vacuum integrated into the unit. It costs about \$30,000, but only one truck is required to accompany it.

While the collection program being implemented this fall "is not the most economical system for the Town," it does address council's concern that a uniform program be put in place for all residents of Halton Hills, Drewlo's report stated.
