Proposal awaiting approval

that the company has an option to buy the land pending approval of the compost proposal from various sources, including the Ministry of the Environment (MOE). He said the company applied for a Certificate of Approval on August 21 and expects to begin building as soon as approvals are received. Larry Hurley, chief operating officer with the Woodbridge company, estimated that the total time for acquiring necessary approvals will be 12 months.

Two weeks ago, members of the Region's planning and public works committee agreed to form a subcommittee to review the design/build proposal for the com-

post facility at the Regional landfill site. The subcommittee was also directed to make recommendations to planning and public works committee about the project before proceeding with proposal calls.

Equity representatives were urged to attend Wednesday's meeting of the planning and public works committee to outline their proposal. All interested parties with proposals about a compost facility to handle Regional waste are welcome to meet with the subcommittee whose membership includes Pomeroy, regional staff, and four regional councillors—Serjeantson from Halton Hills; Barry Lee, Milton; Stephen Sparling, Oakville and Bob Brechin, Burlington.

Officer charged

Halton Regional Police have charged one of their own with assault after a man complained about the use of excess force by an officer.

According to a police media release, at about 4 a.m. October 8, members of the Halton Regional Police Service were investigating a vehicle in the parking lot of an O'Toole's Tavern in Burlington.

A dispute erupted and a 23-year-old Burlington man was arrested for being intoxicated in a public place.

During the arrest, both the arrested person and a Halton Regional Police officer were injured. Both men were taken to Joseph Brant Hospital, treated, and released, the media release said.

Police said an allegation was made that a man was struck with a flashlight during the arrest. As a result of an investigation into this matter, charges have been laid against a 33-year-old Halton Police constable working out of the Burlington division.

The officer has been charged with assault with a weapon and is set to appear in a Burlington court November 10. He is currently off duties as a result of his injuries.

The 23-year-old Burlington man has been charged with assaulting a police officer, and mischief in addition to the intoxication charge. He was to appear October 10 in a Burlington court.

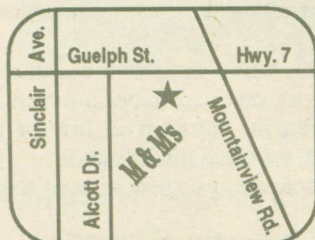
