The amended By-law 89-72 results in these facilities now being entirely smoke-free.

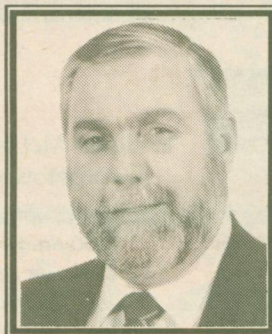

UPPER DENTURES
